By entering the 600 Club Lottery ("the Lottery") you agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions ("the Rules"). The Community Link Foundation ("the Charity") reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions from time to time without prior notice. A hard copy may be obtained by sending a stamped addressed envelope to the Charity at the above address. The Charity is the Promoter of this Lottery, which is a 'Society Lottery' within the meaning of the Gambling Act 2005. The Responsible Person is David Barron. All of the profits from the Lottery go directly towards supporting the general work of the Charity.

1. This Lottery is registered with Sefton Borough Council under registration number 023038.
2. To enter the Lottery, you must be resident in Great Britain and aged 16 or over. It is illegal for individuals under the age of 16 to enter into a lottery. We reserve the right to ask for proof of age from any member and member's accounts may be suspended until satisfactory proof of age is provided. If a ticket is sold unknowingly to, on behalf of, or for a person under the age of 16 he/she will be exempt from the Lottery and will forfeit his/her prize and the stake will be returned.
3. The Lottery is limited to a maximum of 600 members and is a monthly subscription draw.
4. Participation in the Lottery costs £5 per month for one Lottery number, payable by standing order debited from members' nominated bank account on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month. Members can purchase more than one Lottery number.
5. A unique Lottery number(s) will be issued to all members and confirmation of the Lottery number(s) will be communicated via email. Members cannot choose an alternative Lottery number. Your number(s) will be stored by the Charity together with your other details.
6. There will be 1 guaranteed monthly prize of £1,000 and 5 runner-up prizes of £100 each.
7. No substitute will be offered for any prize in the Lottery.
8. All members acknowledge that their payment of £5 per number to enter the Lottery

does not guarantee that they will win any prize.

9. The draw for the prizes will be made at the Charity office at the above address and will be drawn on the last working day of the month. You do not need to be present at the draw to win the lottery. A list of winners will appear on the Charity website or can be obtained by telephoning us on 01704 512120.
10. The winning members will be notified by letter, email or telephone within 7 working days of the draw.
11. The Charity reserves the right to reclaim any prizes issued in error.
12. The Charity's decisions made in accordance with the Rules shall be final and binding.
13. Prizes are sent in the form of a cheque to the winning members at the earliest opportunity. All winning cheques will be sent to the members' address registered with the Charity as at the date of the draw in question. The cheques are valid for a period of six months, after which time they will be considered as a donation to the Charity. However if a member discovers that they may have had a win but have not received/cashed the cheque within that time the Charity can choose to re-issue the winning cheque at their discretion.
14. All members are solely responsible for providing the Charity with their accurate and up-to-date contact details and the Charity will be in no way liable for any failure or inability to contact any member due to any errors, omissions or inaccuracies in the contact details that the entrant has provided. In the event that an entrant changes their contact details, they will be solely responsible for advising the Charity of the change.

16. Lottery membership can be cancelled at any time by notifying the Charity in writing, by phone or via e-mail. It is members' responsibility to cancel their standing order with the bank.
17. The Charity will not be held responsible for the following:-
  - any delays or failures in the postal service or other delivery methods used by the Charity.
  - any delays or failures in any software or other systems used by the Charity for the administration of the lottery.
  - any delays or failures in the banking system used by the Charity or the member.
  - any refusal by the Charity to accept registration of an individual as a member or the cancellation of a member.
  - any failure to enter a chance into the draw.
  - any event beyond the reasonable control of the Charity
  - any theft of any payment or communication sent by post, direct from a bank or building society, fax or email.

18. Nothing within these terms and conditions shall create or should be construed as creating any form of contract between any member and the Charity.

21. The Charity will never sell, rent or grant access of any personal data to any third party.
22. The Charity reserves the right to disqualify any member if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these terms and conditions.
23. The Charity reserves the right to decline to accept an application, cancel an existing subscription, or terminate or suspend the Lottery.
24. Except as specifically set out in these Rules, and to the maximum extent permitted by law, all conditions, warranties and representations expressed or implied by law are hereby excluded.
